## Are students and staff required to wear face coverings?

Yes, students, staff and visitors are required to wear face coverings while on campus. Face coverings are also required on school buses. Face coverings may include: masks, face shields, scarfs, bandanas, and fishing buffs. <u>Click here to read</u> the district Face Covering Policy.

## Will students be eating in the cafeteria?

Yes. Students will be seated facing the same direction and will be assigned to every other seat at their table. Tables will be sanitized before the next grade level is seated.

## Will student have recess?

Yes, students will have 20 minutes of recess each day. Students will wash their hands before and after recess. Students will be required to wear a mask unless engaged in activities that allow for social distancing. Use of the playground will be limited due to sanitizing protocols.

## Will parents and volunteers be allowed on campus?

Parents and volunteers will need to schedule an appointment in order to be on campus. Parents will not be permitted to walk their child to class or to eat lunch on campus at this time.
